## Paper Carp Banner Art Activity

## Paper Carp Banner Instructions for:

## Supplies:

8 ½ inch x 14 inch white paper One chop stick for each carp banner Hole punch Tape Scissors Optional: ribbons

## The pattern is designed to be printed on an 8 ½ x 14 inch sheet of paper.

- 1. Increase the output size to 128%.
- 2. Color the Carp Banner.
- 3. Cut out the areas that are shaded grey.
- 4. Cut out both fins along the dotted lines and fold up along the sides of the body.
- 5. Fold the edge under on the grey line by the head.
- 6. Place the edge marked "A" over the edge marked "B" and edge "C" over edge "D" to create a cylinder and tape both in place.
- 7. Punch two holes over the black dots; this is where your chopstick will go through.
- 8. Run the chopstick through the bottom of the carp banner cylinder.
- 9. Before running the chopstick through the top hole of the banner and to hold the carp banner in place on the chopstick, which will stop the banner from sliding down the chopstick, you will need to place a small paper disc ¼ of an inch down the top of the chopstick. Then, run the chopstick through the top hole of the banner so that it rests on the disc.
- 10. Tie two ribbon streamers at the top of the chopstick.
- 11. Place and glue another small disc on top of the ribbons to hold it in place.
